ACO StormBrixx can be used to replicate several phases of the hydrological cycle. In addition to detention and infiltration water can be harvested for reuse for non-potable uses decreasing the load on potable water supplies. All support Low Impact Development (LID) and LEED initiatives.

At Strathmore High School the StormBrixx Geocellular Stormwater Management System was used for

infiltration purposes because the water treatment plant could not accept the chlorinated water from the pools.

Two separate StormBrixx systems were used, one to dispose of the backwash from the pool and the other to dispose of any drainage from the pool pumphoom.
